Job Description: Conducts behavioral and educational assessments and directs behavioral plan development – interventions and strategies - of children with Autism in an outpatient behavioral health program; identifies function of challenging behavior and pivotal behaviors to target. Monitors and evaluates treatment effectiveness regularly, maintaining high rates of progress. Develops strong collaborative relationships with family and caregivers, professionals and insurance providers. Acts as a clinical teacher who educates, observes, assesses and supervises the educational activities and service delivery of Behavior Technicians.

Job Responsibilities: Flexible work schedule. Full-time, Part-time and Contract options available to include potential for assessments done remotely via video communications.

Related experience is preferred.
